



Conflict Minerals Statement & Policy

A rise in extreme violence and armed conflict fuelled by the exploitation and trade of certain minerals originating in the Democratic Republic of the Congo and surrounding countries is an ongoing concern of businesses, governments, and non-governmental organizations alike. Tin, tantalum, tungsten and gold are commonly referred to as "conflict minerals" regardless of their country of origin.

To align with global best practices and legal requirements in various jurisdictions, Current maintains a Conflict Minerals Policy designed to bring greater supply chain transparency to the use of conflict minerals originating from the Democratic Republic of the Congo and surrounding countries.

Current's policy is to source and use tantalum, tin, tungsten, and gold from sources that have been verified as conflict free and to require suppliers with which it does business to disclose the origin and status of the conflict minerals necessary to the products' functionality or production.

Current is committed to corporate responsibility and to respecting human rights in its own operations and in its global supply chain. Current enforces its commitment through strong internal compliance governance policies (including the appointment of an Enterprise Compliance Officer who oversees compliance adherence for Current's global operation).

In addition, Current requires its Suppliers to adopt policies and establish systems to procure tantalum, tin, tungsten, and gold from sources that have been verified as conflict free, and for Suppliers to provide to Current supporting data on the Supplier's supply chain for tantalum, tin, tungsten, and gold when requested and on a platform to be designated by Current.

Current is also committed to complying with applicable laws concerning the use and disclosure of conflict materials through its Supplier Responsibility Guidelines and requires its Suppliers to warrant doing the same through the Supplier onboarding process and execution of Current's Integrity Guide for Suppliers.
